On the second day your team will allocate resources to the project and create the budget and schedule. The simulation will then allow you to manage your plan as you respond to a range of real-world risks and issues.

At the end of the simulation the stakeholders will provide detailed feedback on your team's performance.



Why Simulate?

Most people learn by doing. Complex skills can best be developed by allowing people to make decisions - and then experience the consequences of those decisions in a safe environment.

Traditional teaching methods alone are ineffective. Passive learning methods such as lectures and slide presentations are not always the most effective methods for developing complex skills. Our simulations are a highly engaging way of learning.
